Formality

- Arrive punctually with your uniform worn correctly. Blazers must be on with ties and scarves worn appropriately.
- Have all your equipment with you and sit in your seating plan.
- Listen during TRANSITIONS to your learning objectives and instructions.

- At the end of your lesson wait until you are released by your teacher.

Personal electronic devices
