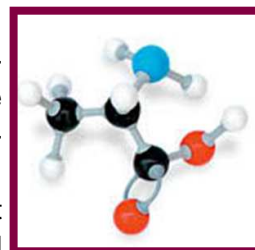

## Drama Production

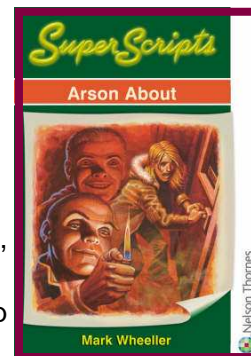

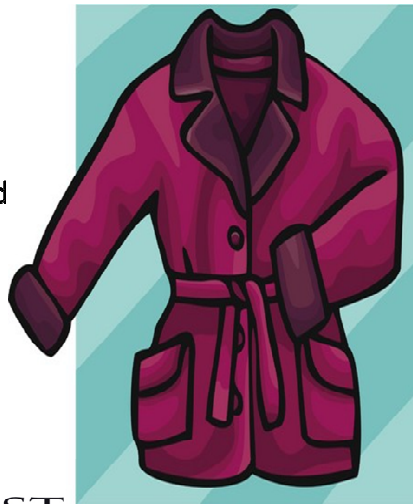
