

Wolgarston High School - 16-19 Tuition Fund Statement 2020-21

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is a £96 million one-off fund for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers and was created to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from COVID-19 for 16-19-year-olds students; specifically, to support small group tuition in English, Maths and other courses where lessons have been disrupted. The students supported must have been on the 16-19 study programme and had not achieved a grade 5 or above in at least one of those subjects by age 16.

Wolgarston High School is eligible to receive £1,455 from this fund for small group tuition, following the guidance. A small group should be no more than five students for this purpose.

How will Wolgarston High School use this fund?

Wolgarston will prioritise support for students who have not achieved a grade 5 in English and/or maths. (Following this support, any outstanding funding will be allocated to support students with grade 5 in English and maths who would benefit from additional support to close any achievement gaps)

We intend to use the funding, as follows:

- Curriculum Resources
- Individual 1-2-1 Tutoring
- IT Devices

This statement is in line with the Government guidance and we have published this statement to demonstrate how this additional funding will be utilised in the academic year 2020/21.
